Chained Endless Falls

Materials

5 ft of Type 1 paracord

2.5 ft of Type 1 paracord

1/2" D Ring

3.7mm Snap Hook Clasp

Beads optional

{Cost for this project starts at \$4.47}

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Step 1: Find the center of your long cord and insert it down through your D ring.

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Step 2: Fold the loop down and insert the two ends through. Pull to form a knot.

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Step 3: Tie a similar knot with the short cord leaving one strand on each side of the first knot as shown.



Step 4: Cross the two short cords behind the two long cords as shown.



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Step 5: Bring the left long strand up behind the crossed strands and up through the loop on the left.

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Step 6: Wrap the right strand behind the crossed strands and up through the loop on the right. Pull all cords snug.

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Step 7: Cross the two short strands behind the long strands as before.

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Step 8: Wrap the left long strand as before, but this time bring it up through the middle between itself and the right strand as shown.

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Step 9: Wrap the right strand and bring it up through the middle between itself and the left strand. Pull all cords snug.



Continue repeating steps 4 through 9. After completing a few of these knots, you can also add beads after step 9 then continue knotting as before.



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Step 10: Once you reach the desired length, rotate everything so your bracelet is at the bottom. Insert both long strands through the bottom of the clasp.



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Step 11: Fold the cords down and bring the right side over the two strands and under the left side as shown.



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Step 12: Bring the left side behind the two strands and up through the loop created by the right cord. Pull tight.



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Weave the ends so everything is secure. Then trim and melt. Try to melt the ends to each other for a little extra security.



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Our bracelet is about 8 inches long and 3/8 inch wide. This bracelet can also be made with any size of paracord and a buckle if desired.



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
