Challenge



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Materials

9 ft yellow 550 paracord

7 ft green 550 paracord

5/8" buckle

{Cost for this project starts at \$4.25}

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Step 1: Melt and join your two cords together.



Step 2: Make a four strand double cow's hitch. [See our tutorial for instructions](#). Try to use the yellow for the inner strands of the bracelet, but be sure your green cord is one of your working ends.

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Step 3: Bring the right yellow cord behind the three strands on the right and over the far left strand.



Step 4: Wrap the same cord around the far left strand and bring it up between the two left strands above itself.



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Step 5: Bring the left green cord behind the three left strands and over the far right strand.



Step 6: Wrap the same cord around the far right strand and bring it up between the two right strands above itself. Pull the working cords tight.



Step 7: Cross the left yellow cord over the bracelet and insert it down between the two right strands.



Step 8: Wrap the same cord over the far right strand and insert it down between the two right strands above itself.



Step 9: Cross the right green cord over the bracelet and insert it down between the two left strands.



Step 10: Wrap the same cord over the left strand and insert it down between the two left strands above itself. Tighten both left and right cords.



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Step 11: Repeat steps 3 through 6.

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Step 13: Repeat steps 7 and 8. Pull both
cords tight. This will alternate your colors
crossing the top. If you want it to be the
same color on top, only repeat steps 3
through 10.

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Weave the ends through a few stitches on
the back, then trim and melt the ends.

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Step 12: Repeat steps 9 and 10.

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Continue repeating steps 3 through 13
until you reach the end of your bracelet.
Use a lacing needle if needed on the last
knots.

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This made a 9 inch bracelet.



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
