Infinity Charm Micro Bracelet

Materials

Two 18 inch pieces of micro cord

Two 3 foot pieces of micro cord

Step 1: With one short piece of cord, fold it in half and insert it down through one end of your charm.

Step 2: Bring both ends of the cord through the loop in the middle of the cord and pull tight to form a knot.

Step 3: Place the middle of one long piece of cord behind your short cords. Bring the left side over the short cords and under the right cord.

Step 4: Bring the right cord behind the center cords and up through the space created by the left cord. Pull tight.

Step 5: Now bring the right cord over the center cords and under the left cord.

Step 6: Bring the left cord behind the center cords and up through the space created by the right cord. Pull tight.

Continue repeating steps 3 through 6 until you reach the desired length to form half of your finished bracelet. Then trim and melt the ends.

Repeat the same process with the other side of the charm. To finish, cross the cords from both ends of your bracelet so they overlap as shown. Using a spare piece from your trimmings, place it behind the cords where they cross.

Tie an overhand knot in each cord end so they won't slip out when adjusted. Trim and melt any excess.

Repeat steps 3-6 a few times enclosing the four cord ends. Trim excess.

This makes a great adjustable bracelet good for stacking. You can create a twisted version of this bracelet by skipping steps 5 and 6 as you braid.
