Micro Cord Bracelet w/Anchor

Materials:

10 ft micro cord

One anchor charm

{Cost for this project starts at \$2.28}

Step 1: Find the middle of your micro cord and loop it around the bottom of the anchor charm as shown.

Step 2: Thread the ends through the hole at the top of the anchor and pull until you reach the desired loop size.

Remove the cord from the bottom of the anchor and lay the cords with the bracelet in the center and the working ends on each side.

Step 3: With the working ends coming up from the hole, move the right cord behind the center two cords and on top of the cord on the left.

Step 4: Bring the left cord over the center two cords and down through the loop on the right. Pull tight.

Step 5: Bring the left cord behind the center two cords and on top of the right cord.

Step 6: Take the right cord and bring it over the center two cords and down through the loop on the left. Pull tight.

Repeat steps 3 through 6 until you have a small loop. Check to make sure your anchor will fit through the loop. Then trim and melt the ends.
