## King Cobra Bracelet with Paraclaw

### Materials:

20 ft of 550 paracord

Paraclaw buckle

Flint fire starter rod (optional)

{Cost for this project starts at \$17.45}

**Step 1:** Find the center of your cord and fold to form a loop. Insert each end of the cord through the holes in the fire starter rod and slide toward the center.

Insert both cords down through the hole on the paraclaw buckle. Measure the desired length of your bracelet.

**Step 2:** Lay the cords as shown with the bracelet in the center and a working end on each side.

**Step 3:** Start a cobra weave by bringing the right side cord over the center cords and under the left cord.

**Step 4:** Bring the left cord behind the center cords and up through the loop formed by the right cord. Pull tight.



**Step 5:** Take the cord on the left and bring it over the center cords and under the cord on the right.



**Step 6:** Bring the right cord behind the center cords and up through the loop created by the cord on the left. Pull tight.



Repeat steps 3 through 6 until you reach your loop. Be sure the loop is large enough to fit over the T bar on the buckle.



Continue repeating steps 3 through 6 tying your knots over the completed weave until you reach the buckle.



Once you reach the buckle, trim and melt any excess cord.
