Solomon's Dragon Bracelet



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Materials:

8.5 feet 550 paracord

2.5 feet 550 paracord

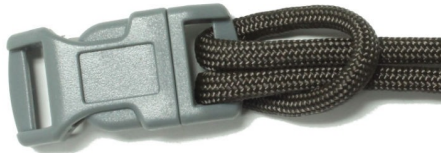
Buckle

{Cost for this project starts about \$2.19}



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Step 1: Find the center of the 8.5 ft piece of paracord and insert it down through one side of the buckle.



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Step 2: Bring both ends through the loop of paracord and pull tight.



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Step 3: Insert the ends down through the opposite side of the buckle and measure to the desired length.



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Step 4: Bring one working end on each side of your center cords.



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Step 5: Begin a cobra weave by bringing the right cord over the center cords and under the left cord.



Step 6: Bring the left cord behind the center cords and up through the loop created by the right cord. Pull tight.

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Step 7: Insert the end of the 2.5 foot piece of paracord under the right center cord and on top of the left center cord.

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Step 8: Continue the cobra weave by bringing the left cord over the center cords and under the right cord.



Step 9: Bring the right cord behind the center cords and up through the loop created by the left cord. Be sure your short cord is above your new knot then pull tight and push up on the knot.

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Step 10: Bring the short piece of cord on top of the right center cord and under the left center cord.

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Continue the cobra weave beginning with step 5 and 6. After step 6, bring the short cord from the left down through the center of the bracelet and repeat steps 8 and 9.



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Repeat the process making sure to alternate between the left and right cords. Once you reach the buckle, trim and melt the ends. *If doing the stitched solomon dragon, don't trim the ends until the stitching is complete.
