Stitched Solomon's Dragon



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Materials:

1 Solomon's Dragon Bracelet

(See other tutorial)

4 ft of micro cord

FID or needle nose pliers

{Cost for this project starts about \$3.99}



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Step 1: Using a fid or pliers, insert the micro cord from the back in the first space as shown. Leave a 2 inch tail.



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Step 2: Insert the micro cord down into the first space directly across from the first stitch. Keep the micro cord to the left of the short cord in your bracelet.



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Step 3: Coming up from the back, insert the micro cord into the space to the side of your previous stitch as shown.



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Step 4: Now bring the micro cord down into the space across from the previous stitch as shown keeping it to the left of the short cord. Repeat steps 1-4 until you reach the other end of the bracelet.



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Our last stitch ended at the arrow. Going across the back, bring the micro cord up through the space directly across from where you ended.



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Continue the same process completing the right sides of each stitch.



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Once you reach the end, secure both ends of micro cord by lacing them through a cord or two on the back side, or melt the ends together. Trim and melt any other excess cords.



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
