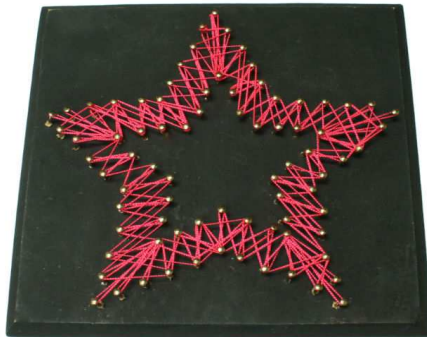


String Art with Nano Cord



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Materials:

About 15-20 ft of Nano Cord

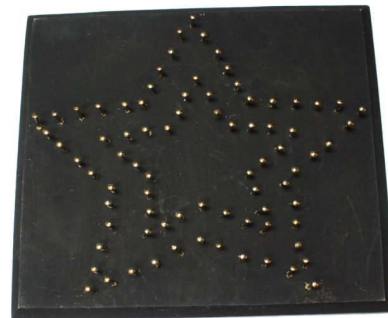
Board

Small Nails about 1 1/2"

{Cost for this project starts at \$7.49}



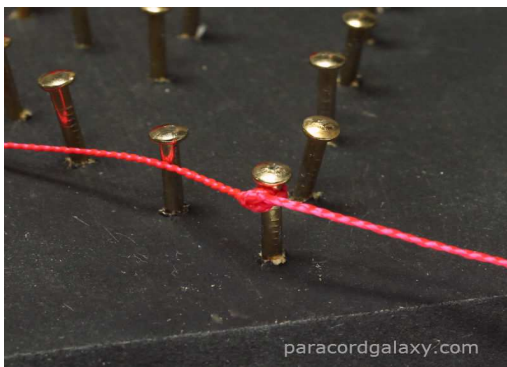
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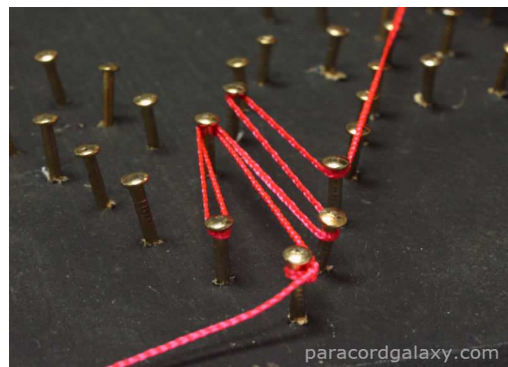
Print a shape or letter and tape it to your board. Hammer nails along the outline leaving even spaces between each.

Carefully remove your pattern.



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Tie a square knot around one of the nails with one end of the nano cord.



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Weave the cord in any direction you want between the nails. Wrap around the nail if needed to keep it secure.

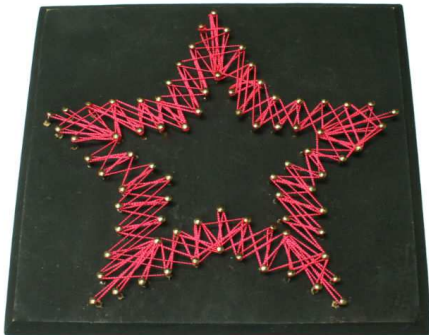
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Once you have reached the desired look, tie the end to a nail like at the beginning.



Trim the end of the cord about $\frac{1}{4}$ inch from the knot. Carefully melt the end until it reaches the knot. Repeat with beginning knot.



The amount of cord needed will vary depending on the size of your pattern and how much you fill the shape. With a 300 ft spool of nano cord you can let your imagination run wild.
