

West Country Whipping Wrap

Materials

About 10 ft of 550 paracord

Object to wrap like a knife

{Cost for this project starts at \$1.99}

Find the middle of your cord and place it behind your object. **Step 1:** Cross the left side over the right side.

Step 2: Bring the cord on the bottom down through the loop to create an overhand knot. Pull tight.

Step 3: Flip the knife to the back side and cross the left cord over the right.

Step 4: Bring the bottom cord down through the loop to create another overhand knot.

Repeat steps 1 through 4 until you reach the end. Insert both cords through the hole at the bottom of the knife.

You can tie an overhand knot with both cords to secure.

Or you can tie a more decorative diamond knot. Tie another knot at the end to form a wrist strap. Trim and melt any excess.
