Zipper Sinnet Bracelet



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Materials:

Two 5 ft pieces of 550 paracord

Or one 10 ft piece of 550 paracord

{Cost for this project starts at \$1.99}

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Step 1: If using two pieces, join them together. Make a loop near the center with the right side over the left side.

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Step 2: Fold the left cord to form a second loop.

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Step 3: Insert the second loop down through the first loop. Pull the first loop closed.

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Step 4: Try to hide where the two pieces of cord are joined. Leave the second loop about an inch long.

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Step 5: Flip the loop upside down. Form a loop with the right cord with the working end on the bottom.

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Step 6: Fold the left cord and bring it up through the first loop.

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Step 7: Pull the right cord to close the loop tight.

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Step 8: Fold the right cord and insert it through the new loop. Pull the left cord to close the loop tight.

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Step 9: Fold the left cord and insert it through the loop. Pull the right cord to close the loop tight.

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Continue repeating steps 8 and 9 alternating left and right cords until you reach the desired length.

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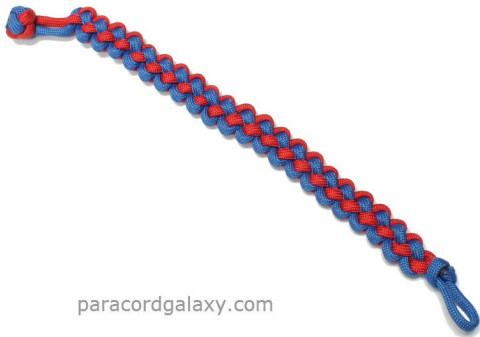
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To finish, insert the end not forming the last loop through the loop. Then pull the loop closed.



Use the remaining length to tie a diamond knot or other desired knot.



If you would like to have this as a quick deploy bracelet, we suggest using a simple overhand knot rather than a diamond knot.
