The Curling Millipede (also known as a Bootlace Bracelet) is an eye catching bracelet that's quick and easy to make. It sells well at craft fairs and outdoor markets.

Choose bright complementary colors for the paracord and buckle. It's also a great weave for sports bracelets in the colors of local sports teams.

For this paracord project you'll need two 5 foot lengths of [550 paracord](#) and a [3/8" side release buckle](#). The 3/8" buckle is a nice match for the width of this bracelet. We don't recommend using a [larger buckle](#) unless you use larger diameter cord like [750 paracord](#).

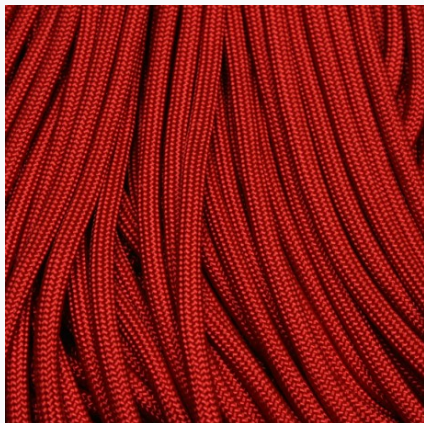
